FA International Relations Statement about the Middle East - ANARCHISTS AGAINST WAR

Many wars are underway, economic and social, environmental, religious. They all involve genocide against women, particularly in Islamic theocracies. However, the only wars that are widely covered by the media, and which are the subject of all kinds of press releases within the hour, are those of interest to capitalism and its powers, militarized conflicts that involve nationalism and border demarcations, and therefore the control of exploitable wealth, the interests of finance, the sales of arms and logistics, the industrial stakes of reconstruction, etc., in short the wars waged by States, their armies and their militias.

The war in the Middle East pits the imperialism and colonialism of a far-right government, which defends the State of Israel against the dictatorship of an armed movement in Gaza, Hamas, which aspires to create an Islamist state, a theocracy of which Palestinians will be the first victims.

The Fédération Anarchiste, anti-capitalist, anti-state, anti-nationalist, anti-militarist, antisexist, anti-racist, anti-clerical, says no to war. Anarchists are on the side of civilian victims, prisoners of conscience, in Israel or elsewhere, who refuse to serve in the army, Israeli women and men reservists who refuse war, women and men in Gaza who suffer the double punishment (Hamas and the Netanyahu government), atheists on both sides of the wall.

The French-speaking Fédération Anarchiste pays tribute to the companions of Israel, "Anarchists against the wall", who, according to initial testimonies, were among the victims of the bloody Hamas attack on October 7 against a peaceful festival. music in the open air "on the other side".

The Fédération Anarchiste supports Israeli groups resisting the war (organization of anti-war demonstrations, civilian direct intervention de-escalation teams, etc.).

The Anarchist Federation is in favor of a libertarian Palestinian resistance not subservient, as it is today, to a single political movement and a religious diktat.
